We do not believe that violence can bring peace and we are devastated by its current use in Israel and Palestine.

But the violence did not begin on October 7th 2023.

240 Palestinians had already been killed by the Israeli army or settlers since the beginning of 2023.

Palestinians face the daily violence of barriers separating them from their families, farmland, healthcare; of the blockade of Gaza for 17 years, preventing access to clean water, building materials, drugs; of detention without trial of thousands of Palestinian youth; of the violent response to any peaceful protest; of attacks on their land, homes and lives by Israeli settlers; of bombing assaults on Gaza which had already killed over 5,000 people before the start of this year.

Israel cannot be secure until it ends this violence and withdraws from its Occupation of the West Bank, ends the blockade of Gaza and stops its discrimination against Palestinians in Israel.

The UK government can play its part by

- dropping its unconditional support to the occupying power;
- by stopping arms deals with Israel;
- by supporting those bodies such as councils and pension funds who decide to divest from companies enabling Occupation and settlement.
